Exhibition Objectives and Eligibility

The Living Arts and Science Center in collaboration with YAC is proud to invite Fayette County's high school students to exhibit their art work in a juried exhibition. To be eligible you must currently be a high school student in Fayette County, this includes any public, private, or home school students. The exhibit will be open to all art work that can be presented on the wall, including 2-D, drawing, photography, printmaking, sculptural work, etc. This exhibition will be juried by Rae Goodwin a professor at UK who teaches visual arts foundations. LASC is a non-profit organization that offers creative and unique classes and programming in the arts and sciences for students and visitors of all ages.

Submission Guidelines

Entry Deadline: May 3rd 2010. Please include the following:

- ✓ Completed Application Form.
- ✓ 1 or 2 Images of each piece. You may submit up to three pieces.

Image Guidelines

LASC only accepts digital images for consideration. The gallery will retain the submitted images of accepted artwork and reserves the right to use the selected images in publications and gallery publicity. Actual art must be available to be displayed at LASC during the specified exhibit times. Please format images according to the following:

- All digital images must be formatted as JPEGs (highest quality)
- Please label images with your last name and entry number. Example: Smith1.jpg Smith1.Detail1.jpg

Need Images of your work taken?

There will be two opportunities for students to get images of their work taken, and to submit their entry on the spot.
